



Code of Conduct

Members of the Demolition Contractors Association (Qld) Inc. are bound by a Code of Conduct based on the following ethical principles:

1. To act at all times with honesty, integrity and responsibility and in the spirit of good faith and fair dealings with clients and other industry participants.
2. Comply with all Workplace Health and Safety legislative requirements, ie: Workplace Health and Safety Act and Regulations, relevant codes of practice, relevant Australian Standards (as per State Government legislation).
3. Avoid conflicts of interest which may be seen as detrimental to the Association.
4. Adhere to, and promote, the Association's objectives:
 - To act as the representative body for member demolishers, recyclers and asbestos contractors in dealings with government and regulatory authorities, other industry sectors and the general public.
 - To promote and seek the recognition of members as professionals, and to promote public awareness of the demolition, recycling,, asbestos removal and associated industries.
 - To improve the standard of operational practices within the industry for the benefit of workers and the protection of public health and safety.
 - To provide members with specific information to enhance work practices, including workplace health and safety, and industrial relations information.
 - To adopt and promote a code of conduct for the guidance of members as to the proper professional conduct within the industry.
 - To promote interest in, and progress of, any matter which will improve the technical and general knowledge and efficiency of the industry.
